## State Center Native Dies, Colo Burial

NEVADA — Funeral services were held Saturday, Dec. 8 at the Ryan Funeral Home in Nevada for Edna Elmore Lounsberry, native of State Center, who passed away the previous Wednesday of acute leukemia in the Iowa Methodist Hospital in Des Moines. The Rev. Marvin Hulse officiated and burial was in the Colo Cemetery.

Born on a farm east of State Center on Sept. 29, 1894, she was the daughter of Edwin and Sarah Elmore. The family moved into town soon afterward and she attended the State Center School, graduating in 1912.
