Dec. 14, 1898, to Sept. 25, 1995

Anna M. Lounsberry, 96, of Colo died of congestive heart failure at Colonial Manor in Zearing on Monday, Sept. 25.

She was born to Arah and Mary (Brodie) White on Dec. 14, 1898, at Colo. A lifelong resident of Colo, she graduated from Colo High School in 1919. On Nov. 28, 1921, she married John Divine Lounsberry at Colo. She worked as a telephone operator at the Colo Telephone Company. She was a member of the Colo United Methodist Church, of the Colo Order Eastern Star chapter and of the Colo Clover Leaf Club.
