

Doris Winnifred Lounsbury, 69, of RR1, Colo IA, died Sunday, Sept 18, 1988, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines IA. Death was due to cancer. She was born Feb 13, 1919, in Big Wells TX to John K and Edythe B (Armstrong) Zeman.

She was married to W.H. Lounsbury on July 18, 1942 at Eagle Pass TX.
